Editorial Note

10th Conference on Medicinal and Aromatic Plants of Southeast European Countries (10th CMAPSEEC) was jointly organized by the University of Zagreb, Faculty of Agriculture, Zagreb, Croatia, Institute for Adriatic Crops and Karst Reclamation, Split, Croatia and the Centre of Excellence for Biodiversity and Molecular Plant Breeding (CroP-BioDiv), Zagreb, Croatia in collaboration with Association for Medicinal and Aromatic Plants of Southeast European Countries (AMAPSEEC).

AMAPSEEC was founded in 1998 on the initiative of the Institute for Medicinal and Aromatic Plant Research 'Dr Josif Pančić', Belgrade, Serbia. Ever since the Association served as an important network connecting scientists interested in medicinal and aromatic plants. After the foundation of the Association, the Conferences were organized in different countries every second year starting with the 2000, when the 1st CMAPSEEC Conference was organized in Arandjelovac, Serbia and hosted by the late Mihailo Ristić (1953-2017), the founder and the first president of AMAPSEEC. Ever since, the CMAPSEEC Conferences have greatly contributed to the development of various fields of research concerning medicinal and aromatic plants. It was our great privilege to host the 10th Jubilee Conference in Split and pay tribute to all the past efforts in organizing our meetings.

The Conference was attended by 168 participants from 17 countries (Albania, Austria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Lithuania, Macedonia, Montenegro, Poland, Romania, Serbia, Slovakia, Turkey) and followed the established tradition in gathering scientists, young researchers and entrepreneurs involved in medicinal and aromatic plants production, processing and use. The scientific programme covered a broad range of topics organized into three sections: (1) Medicinal and aromatic plants ecology, diversity and ethnobotany, (2) Phytochemical analysis, pharmacology, biological activity and toxicity, and (3) Cultivation, breeding and biotechnology of medicinal and aromatic plants.

The Scientific and Organizing Committee wishes to express gratitude to all the participants and the reviewers whose efforts and expertise significantly contributed in achieving scientific quality of the papers.
